THE TONES MAKING WAVES AT TRANQUIL WATERS

Over a few cold beverages on New Year's Eve 2009, our resident Anne came up with an idea that there should be a choir at Tranquil Waters.

The perfect name for the group was The Tranquil Tones of course! Twenty-six days later the first concert was performed on Australia Day 2010. Anne initially took on the role of Musical Director, however upon her return after a short holiday she decided to pass this role on to Bev. Anne is now in charge of wardrobe and Bev is still in the position of Musical Director some eight years later. Margaret became the accompanist after Yvonne vacated the role some years ago.

Bev was a professional ballroom dancer and had no experience in singing except for choir participation during school years.

As Musical Director she has overseen The Tranquil Tones perform 449 songs as participants in 42 concerts. Most of the group are amateurs, some never singing before, with a couple of professional musicians being part of the group over the years.

Every Tuesday choir practice is held and the staging of the bi-annual concerts is very much a team affair. To assist with the concert workload the group has input into what songs and skits they would like to see performed in the upcoming concerts.

The Tranquil Group management very kindly provided shirts for the group to wear whilst performing. The Tranquil Tones even have their own "Roadie" Kieron, who works tirelessly with the concert set up and any other assistance the group needs.

When asked which concert was her favourite, Bev replied without hesitation that the May concert, full of show tunes, was a thrill for her. Bev surprised us with her first solo.

Bev has said that The Tranquil Tones has become her life. From the enjoyment that the concerts give our residents, staff and families we are very thankful for the time, effort and fun given by the very talented and entertaining group.

The concerts are held to coincide with a Sunday Dinner in our Community Centre and the cost is for the two-course catered meal; the entertainment is free!

RESIDENT PROFILE

Terry Donovan OAM – The straight shooter



As we have just completed the very popular 2018 Commonwealth Games on the Gold Coast, the time has never been better to place the spotlight firmly on our Tranquil Waters resident Ms Terry Donovan.

Earlier this year Terry was awarded a Medal of the Order of Australia for her services to archery.

This award follows a sporting career spanning some 54 years, four Olympic Games between 1972 and 1984 and the 1982 Commonwealth Games held in Brisbane. The list of Terry's achievements is vast and includes winning 14 Australian Championship medals in the open division.

Terry, a life member of the Mount Petrie Bowmen Club, has held many positions on the committee over 40 years, including President, Secretary and Treasurer. She is also a life member of Regional Governance for Archery and the Archery Alliance Hall of Fame.

Terry was always involved in sport during her school years and her start in archery was prompted by a shoulder injury whilst playing social tennis. Her mother nagging her to get involved in something other than lounging around and reading books.

A fashion layout in a popular women's magazine in 1964 featuring sports fashion on models with archery equipment was the catalyst.

Terry honed her craft over a number of years while living in Toowoomba. She worked full time and was able to practise shooting in the early mornings, however she did need to wait for the sun to rise so she could see. This proved problematic as the sun rose behind the target and shone in her eyes.

One of the kind members of her Archery Club moved a target to the back of the bus sheds where her father worked. This was a better solution for Terry as it was located right next door to her home.

In the Sydney Nationals in 1970 she was the new kid on the block. At the official practice day her wrist sling broke and her bow went bouncing down the field. This was not a common occurrence and very embarrassing for her but it was one experience she never forgot and one she looks back at with amusement.

In the '60s archery was not included in the Olympic Games, however it was to be reinstated in the 1972 games – to compete was Terry's goal. Terry made it and her career highlight is walking out into the arena of the Munich Olympic Games, an experience never forgotten.

When Terry first received an email advising her of the award she thought it was a scam. She researched the award online and discovered that the letter was real and she then completed the required paperwork to accept the award. She has since learnt that club members had nominated her for the OAM in September 2016. The instatement of her OAM is to be held at Government House.
